Vladimir Putin

- Born Leningrad, Soviet Union (now Saint Petersburg, Russia) 1952
- Graduated Leningrad State University (now Saint Petersburg State University) 1975
- Joined KGB 1975
- Appointed as an advisor on international affairs to the mayor of Leningrad, Anatoly Sobchak 1990
- 2000-2004 First presidential term
- 2004-2008 Second presidential term
- 2012-2018 Third presidential term
- 2018-present Fourth presidential term
- Net worth estimated at \$200 billion

Jared Polis

- Born Boulder Community Hospital 1975
- Moved to La Jolla, CA at age 5
- Attended La Jolla Country Day School
- Graduated Princeton 1996
- Elected to Colorado 2nd Congressional District 2009-2019
- 4th wealthiest politician in the U.S.
- First openly gay governor
- Net worth estimated at +\$400 million
- Sold his parent's company in 1999 for \$780 million
- Sold his company, ProFlowers, to Liberty Media for \$500 million in 2005

How It All Started... the real reason?



On July 22, 2013, Polis filed a complaint in Denver District Court seeking a restraining order on a drilling rig near his vacation home in Weld County.

After the rig incident, Polis promised, ***“It is over....
this part of our Colorado dream is over.”***

Russia and LNG

- When the Sakhalin II project is fully on stream, it will supply around 5% of the world's LNG and make a significant contribution to strengthening global energy security." (February 18, 2009)
- Sakhalin, formerly owned by Shell Exploration, was "***nationalized***" by Gazprom. Gazprom currently owns 51% of the project.

April 4, 2009

Kovykta Gas Field

- Reserves amount to 70 TCF of Natural Gas
- More than 600 million barrels of gas condensate
- 3-4 BCF gas/day

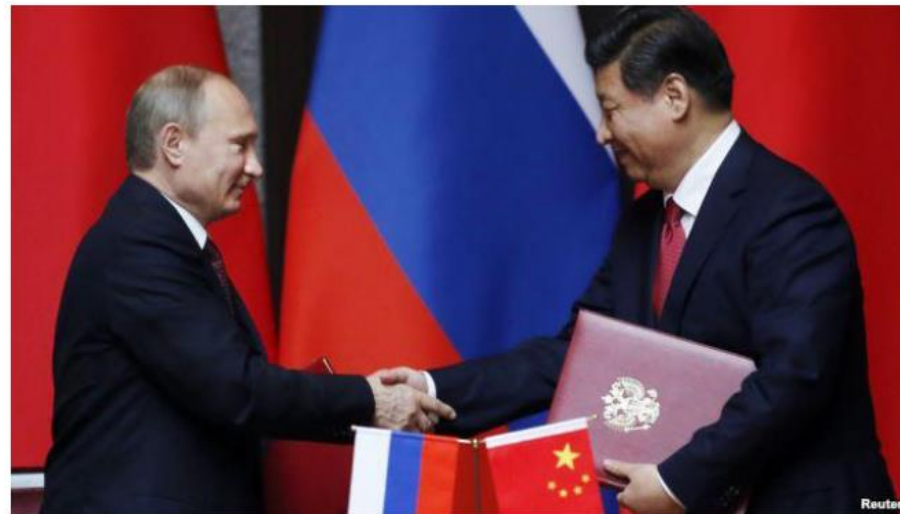


History of Kovykta Gas Field (weaponize your regulatory agencies)

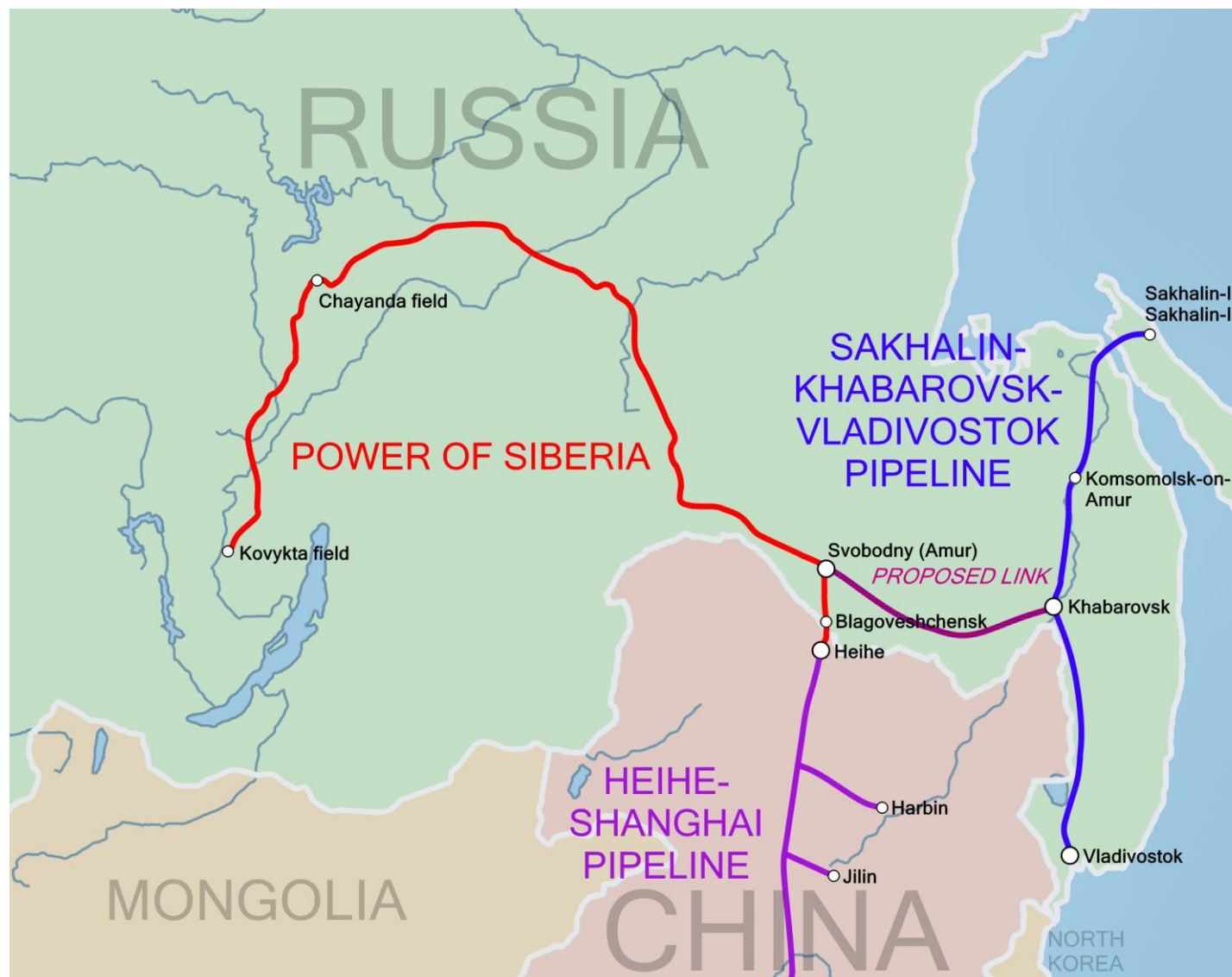
- **1987** – Kovykta Gas Field discovered (enough natural gas to power Asia for 10 years)
- **1987** – License to develop held by Russia Petroleum (Majority of RP owned by TNK-BP)
- **2003 – 2005** TNK-BP denied access to critical Gazprom pipeline
- **June 2006** – Top TNK-BP Engineer Enver Ziganshin murdered three days after meeting with Russia's EPA equivalent, Rospirodnadzor on compliance issues
- **June 2007** – TNK-BP offered to sell stake for \$700-\$900 million to Gazprom, but deal never materialized
- **June 2010** – Russia Petroleum filed for bankruptcy

History of Kovykta

- TNK-BP attempted to sell field to state owned Rosneft but failed
- **March 2011** – Gazprom bought Russia Petroleum's assets, including Kovykta, for \$711 million
- May 2014 – Russia and China sign \$400 billion 30-year gas supply agreement, Kovykta natural gas will be delivered to China via the Power of Siberia Gas Pipeline



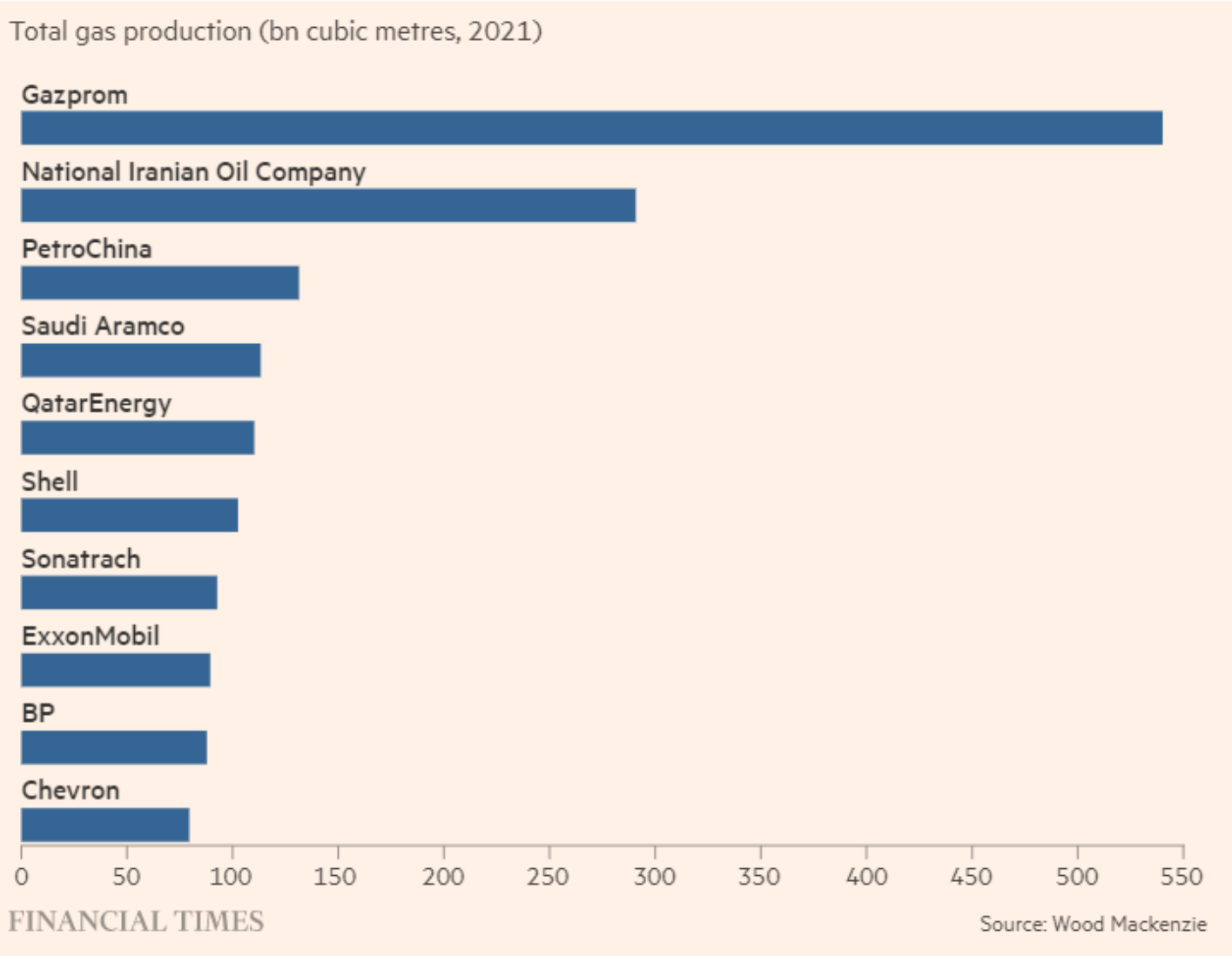
Power of Siberia Gas Pipeline Map

- 130 X... Polis spent \$1.3 million on a State Board of Education race his opponent spent \$10,000 (margin of victory 90 votes out of 1.3 million total votes cast).
- 3 X... Polis spent \$5.3 million in his primary race vs. Joan Fitz-Gerald (spent \$1.8 million)

USGS concluded in 2016 that Colorado's Piceance Basin holds 66 TCF of recoverable natural gas

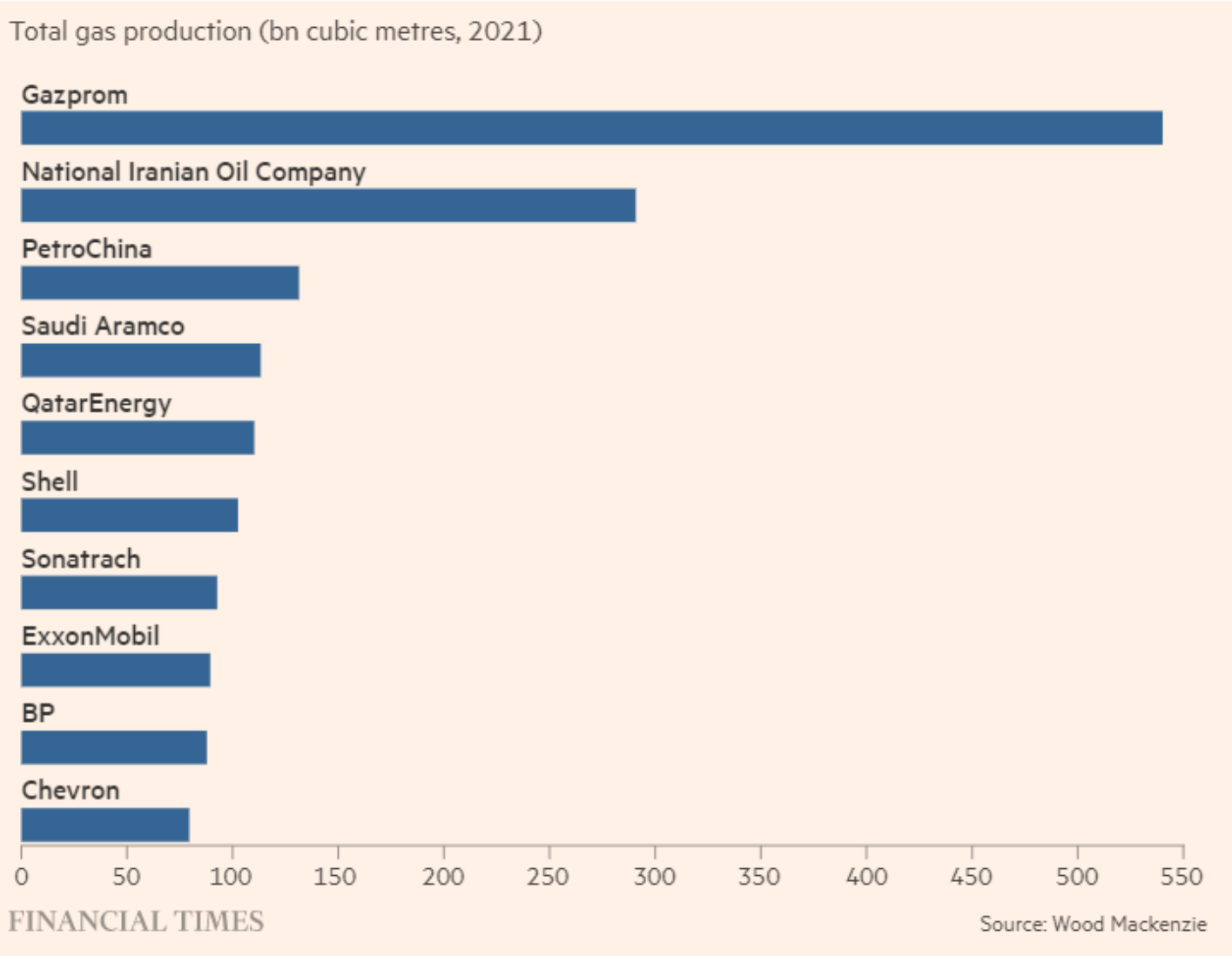

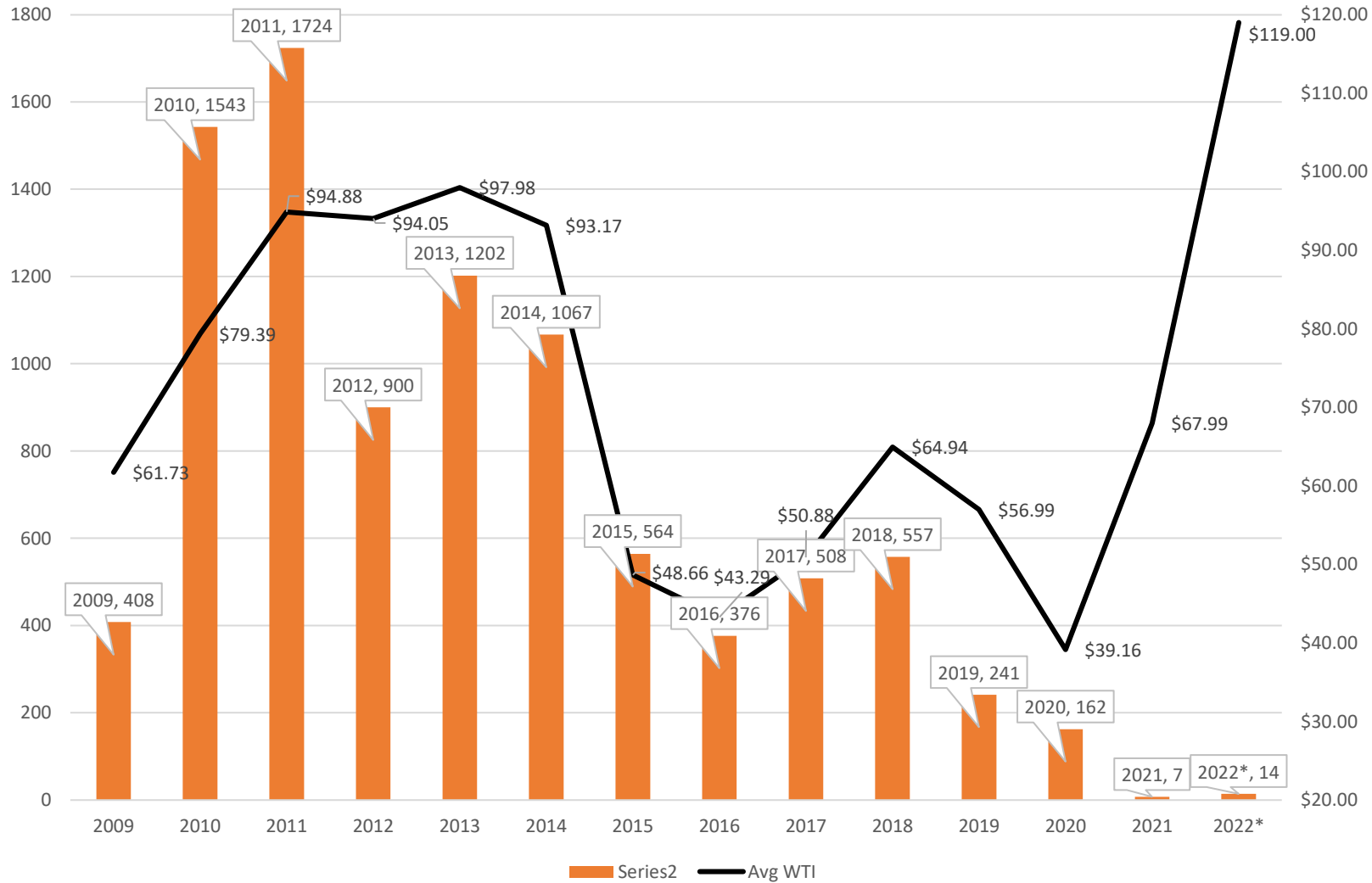

- Adopted and began to implement a zero CO2 emissions by 2040 policy
- In 2014, as a Colorado Congressman, Polis paid for and sponsored two anti-Oil and Gas ballot initiatives (Coloradans for Safe and Clean Energy).
- Appointed Boulder Attorney Jeff Robbins (an anti-oil and gas activist) to be Chairman of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.
- Refused to send “**Exception Letter**” to EPA on ozone non-attainment standard, triggering significant regulatory and mandated control over Oil and Gas Industry.

- Senate Bill 181 sponsored and signed into law by Governor Polis (effectively ratchets Colorado's Oil and gas industry into non-existence)

SB181 Impact:

- Oil and Gas Industry estimates its economic impact at \$30 billion.
- 33,024 direct employee job losses in 2019
- Added \$200 million dollars/year in new regulatory direct costs.
- Oil and Gas production is down 20% in Colorado since Polis took office

U.S. Shale Revolution?



US LNG exports are a priority concern for Putin. US LNG bound for Europe undercuts Russia's domination of the European Gas Market.

Putin spends \$95 million on fracking disinformation campaign

Former NATO Secretary General Anders Fogh Rasmussen backs up the Romanian claim. He said in London recently,

“Russia, as part of their sophisticated information and disinformation operations, engaged actively with so-called nongovernmental organizations – environmental organizations working against shale gas – to maintain [Europe’s] dependence on imported Russian gas.”

- Russia Today television ran endless anti-fracking stories, including one that said, ***“Frackers are the moral equivalent of pedophiles.”***

Polis Spin

- After his 1st successful run for governor, he was asked if his race was, ***“An election or auction?”***
- 98% of his gubernatorial campaign dollars raised (\$23.4 million) came from his own checkbook.
- ***“The other side will always have more money than the democrats, that’s just a reality”***- Jared Polis

According to the Denver Post:

- ***“The Democratic congressman does not want to ban all drilling with hydraulic fracturing, he insisted- and even compared those who do to fringe groups seeking to outlaw fluoride in water.”***

Polis Spin Circa 2014

- In a July 16th, 2014 statement, Rep. Polis said these initiatives will not harm the oil and gas industry, and even claimed they ***“will allow our state to continue to benefit from the oil and gas boom that brings jobs and increased energy security.”*** In June, Rep. Polis said: ***“I think that like myself most Coloradans support fracking and the all-of-the above approach.”***

- ***Polis appoints new (in 2020) Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commissioners but ignores 4 critical issues****
 - With respect to setbacks; the absence of any measured and confirmed scientific impacts within the setback boundaries.
 - The unimpeachable will of Colorado Voters who rejected nearly identical setbacks not two years ago.
 - The recommendations of the non-partisan COGCC staff.
 - The explicit stated directives of the prior governor who appointed them.

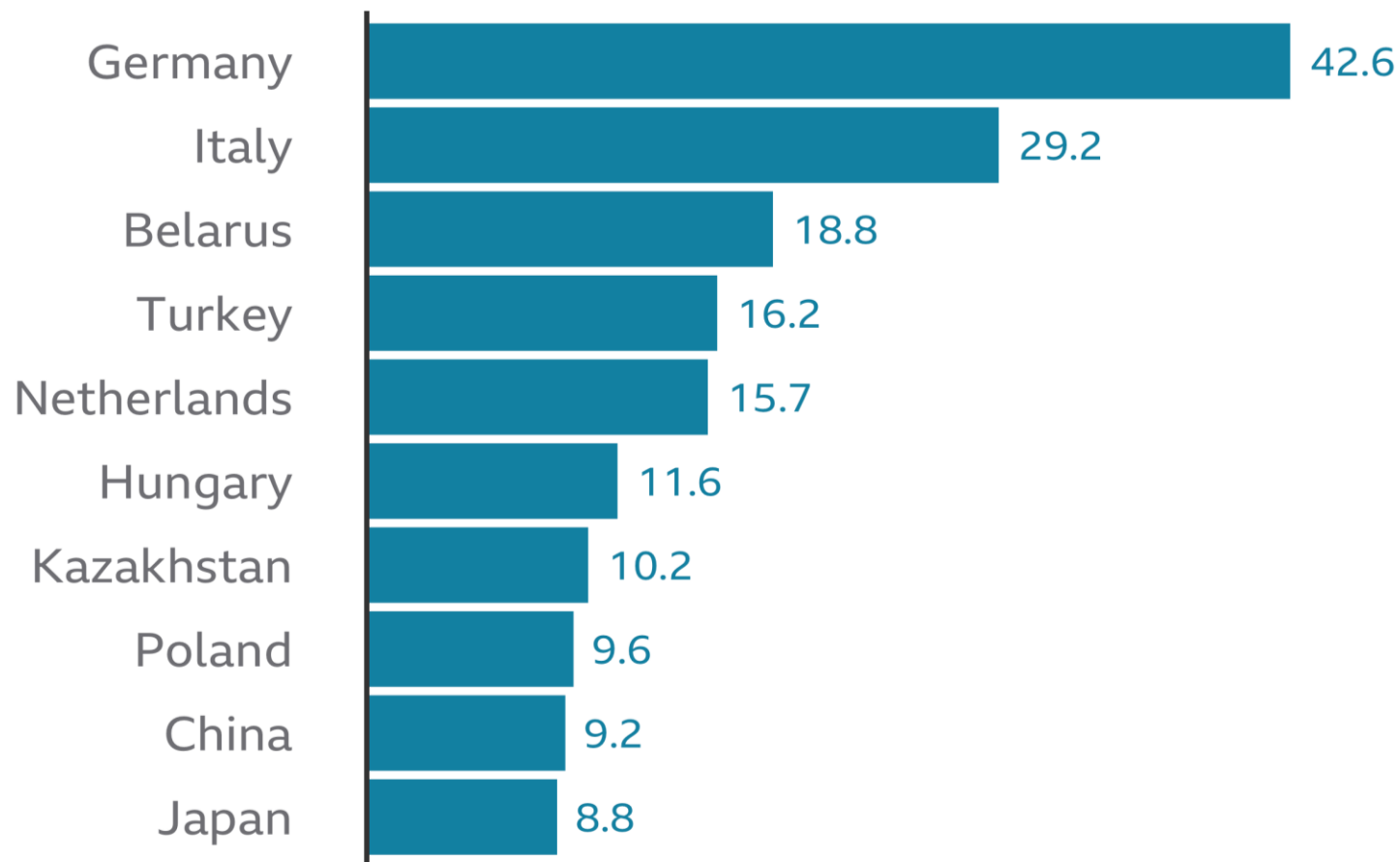

Russia's gas exports

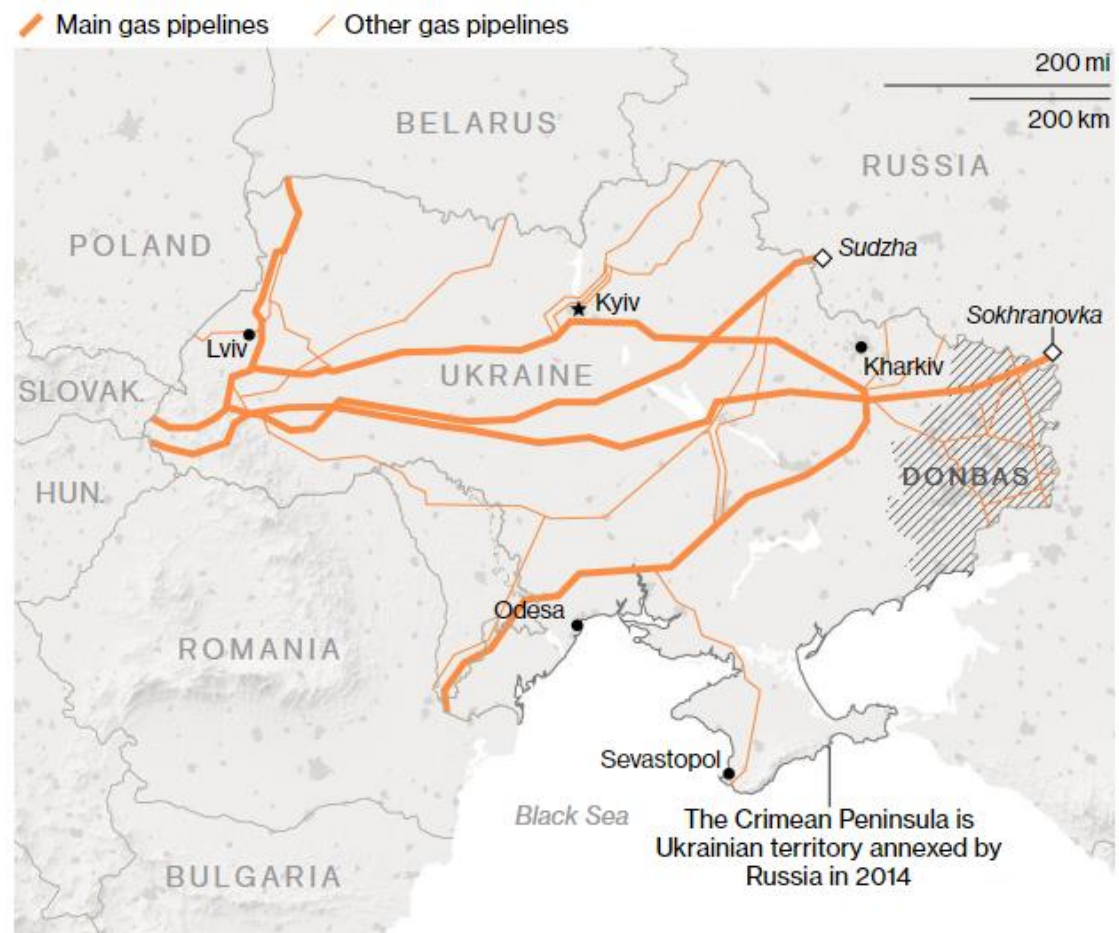
Countries by billion of cubic metres imported from Russia

Germany's Angst

Germany's pursuit of peace in trade with Russia failed

“Roughly half of Germany’s homes rely on natural gas for their heating, and 55 percent of the country’s gas comes from Russia.”

A near-term cut-off of Russian gas supplies to Germany could cost their economy \$120 billion. Germany would be rationing natural gas.

Germany's About Face Gives Hope

“We must change course to overcome our dependence on imports from individual energy suppliers.”

This will include building two liquefied natural gas (LNG) terminals, one in Brunsbuettel and one in Wilhelmshaven, and raising its natural gas reserves.

Create a New Society



“Let’s not kid anybody,” said Leon Panetta, “Putin’s main interest is to try and restore the Old Soviet Union. I mean that’s what drives him.”

- Legislation calls for a **26 percent reduction in emissions by 2025** and a **50 percent reduction by 2030**. Those targets are measured against Colorado's 2005 emissions.



“This is by far the most ambitious and expansive planning document that Colorado has ever produced on climate change,” Polis said.

COLORADO AIMS TO “ELECTRIFY THE HECK” OUT OF EVERYTHING, GAS STOVETOPS POTENTIALLY TARGETED

“A swift transition from natural gas-fired power sources to electrification has become a top priority for Colorado Gov. Jared Polis as leading officials in his administration aim to stop fossil fuel use by consumers. Such a move raises the specter of higher costs for consumers and other impacts, especially if they lose access to popular home appliances like gas stovetops.”*

Rule Forever

- **Vladimir Putin passes law that may keep him in office until 2036**

“The Russian president signed the legislation on Monday, ending a year-long process to “reset” his presidential terms by rewriting the constitution through a referendum-like process that his critics have called a crude power grab.”

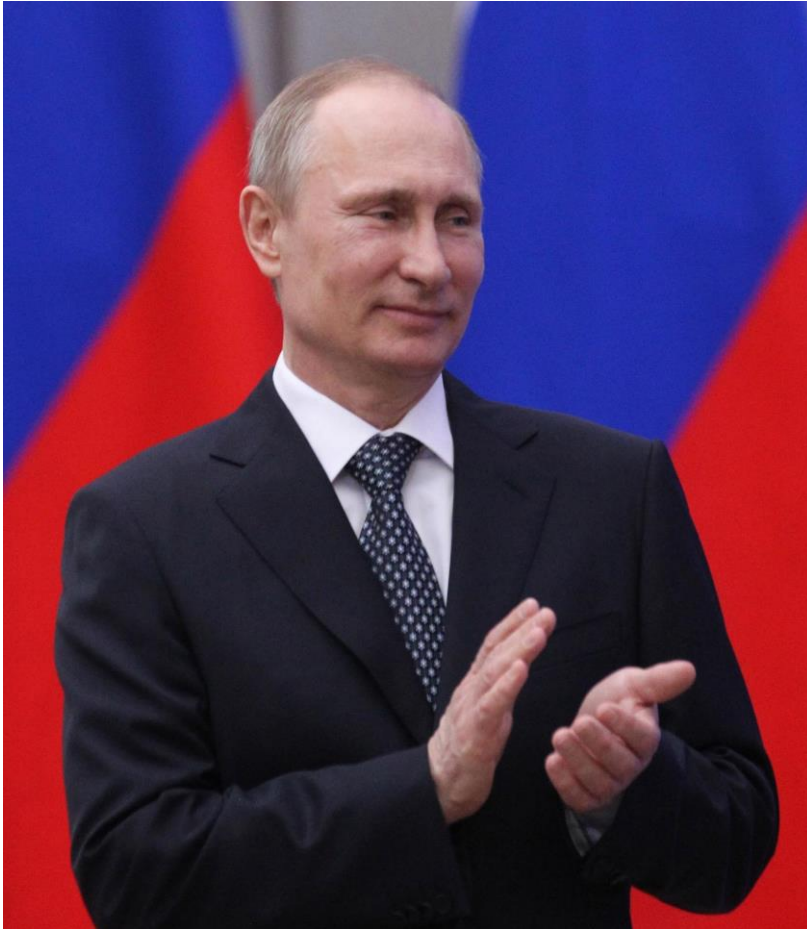

Polis Steps Into National Spotlight*



If Polis wins another term as Colorado Governor and two terms as U.S. President he will be in office until 2034, meaning he would be in public office for a total of 33 years.*

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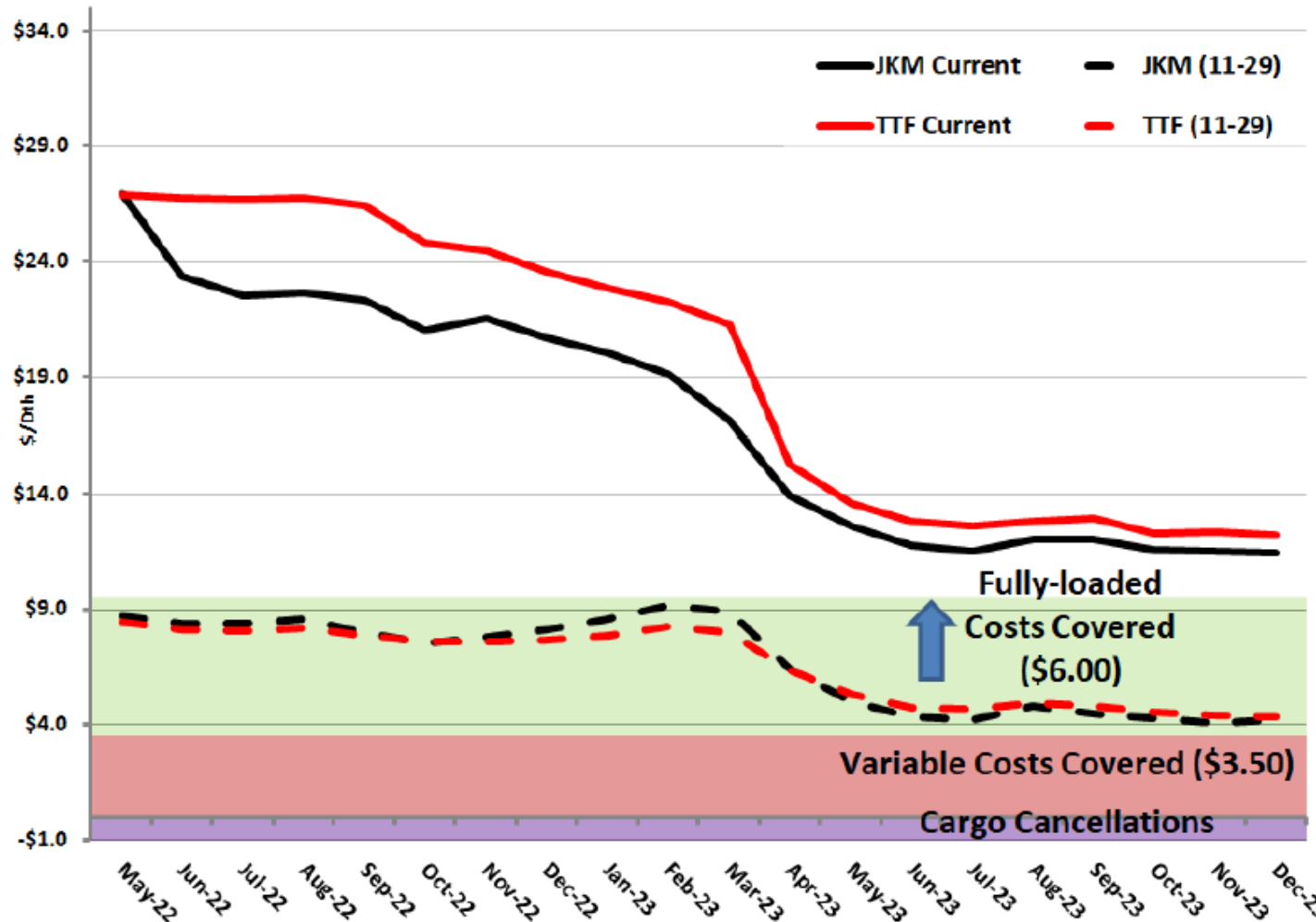

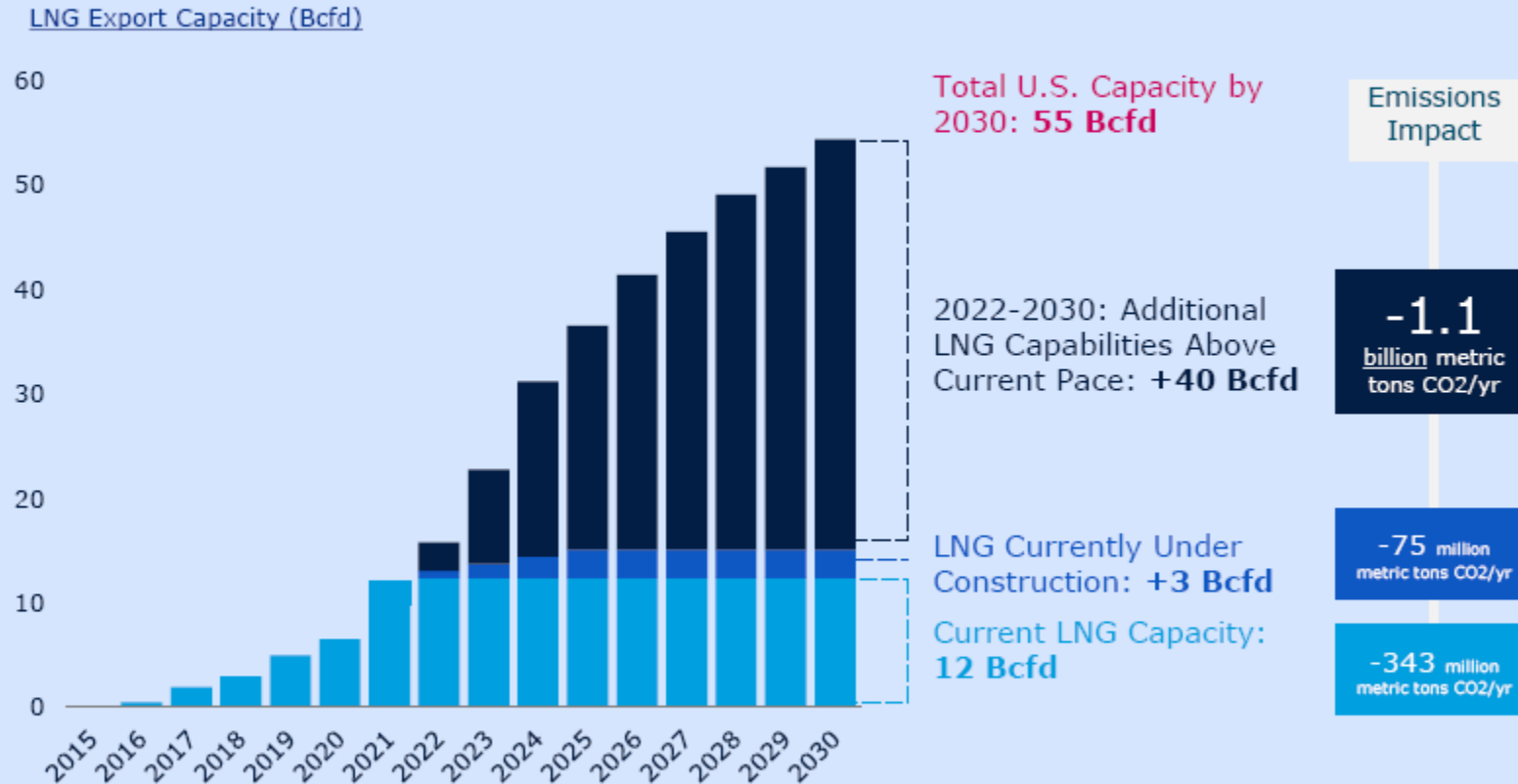
Near Term Outlook Margins



Margins through '23 well above fully loaded costs. Supply demand balance remains tight due to greater demand in Asia and Europe. Competition for cargos between Asia and Europe and Russia/Ukraine conflict sustaining elevated prices in both markets.

Nord Stream 2 will not enter service for the foreseeable future with current situation in Europe

Projected LNG Export Capacity Through 2030¹



1. Based on an internal study, U.S can produce 40 bcf production surplus by 2030. 2. There is 3 bcf capacity currently under construction, and another 3 bcf anticipated. Therefore, projected incremental capacity is 6bcfd. To reach an additional 40 bcf, the incremental needs to be 6x, which is in line with non-obstructed pace. 3. Assuming 3 bcf under construction, and 40 bcf additional capacity by 2030.

European LNG infrastructure

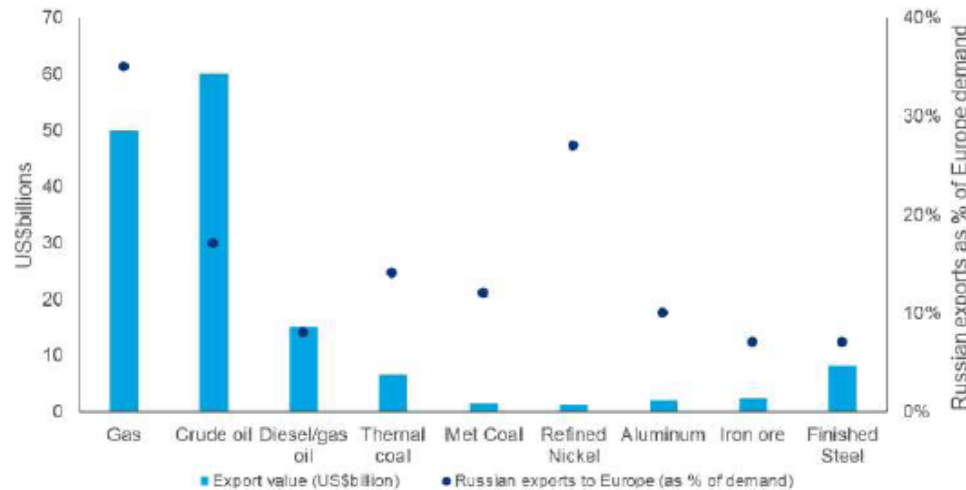

Russian gas supply to Europe and China

European exposure to Russian commodity imports and its monetary value (2021)

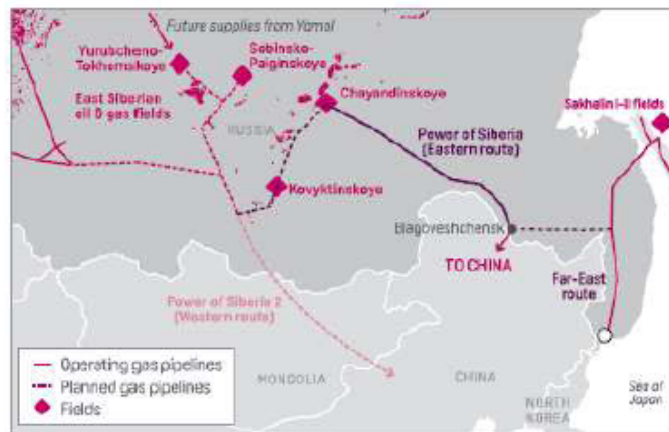


- Russian gas and oil have a significant share of the EU Mkt.
- Russian gas supplies ~38% of European demand
- Russia supplies ~50% of Germany's demand and ~30% of Italy's demand
- May be limits to increase pipe supply from non-Russian sources

- Russian piped gas flows to Europe on the following routes;
- Nord Stream 1 flowing at capacity 5 Bcfd
- Nord Stream 2 (uncertain outcome), capacity of 5 Bcfd
- Yamal (via Poland) capacity of 3.2, not flowing at capacity
- 3 pipes thru Ukraine, capacity 8.1 Bcfd, limited flow currently due to higher cost of transport. Russia has a 3.8 Bcfd flow or pay kt. with Ukraine thru '24
- TurkStream and Blue Stream (via Turkey to Italy /southern EU), capacity of ~3 Bcfd

- Russia currently supplies China and is looking to expand
- Russia supplies China via the Power of Siberia PL; 3.9 Bcfd, supplying ~7% of its gas demand
- In discussions to develop Power of Siberia 2, 5.1 Bcfd
- Entered into new long-term gas agreement with China's CNPC for 1 Bcfd
